

## Picture Me

**Activity:** Present a “brand” or a model of the dynamic relationship of your top five Talent Themes — how your top five Talent Themes work together. Create something that captures YOU and your talents completely.

- Be creative.
- Consider using visual metaphors to represent the interrelationship of your talents.
- You can use any media you wish to build your model. Some ideas or suggestions:
  - A photo
  - A symbol
  - A poem or a quote
  - Drawing or sketch
  - Build a sculpture from clay, Tinker Toys, or Lego sets.
  - For the over-achievers (and you know who you are...) you might consider using a Microsoft PowerPoint or Adobe Flash presentation of a three-dimensional model.

### Example:



**STRATEGIC:** Mapping a trail to get to the Pot of Gold, through the desert, lots of things to consider in the plan.

**POSITIVITY:** Not only one rainbow, but a DOUBLE rainbow-the bad stuff is over when the rainbow appears.

**EMPATHY:** The arid desert juxtaposed with the thirst quenching rain-all those emotions/feelings that are right there for me to see.

**COMMUNICATION:** I want to tell you the story of what happened just before that double rainbow...

**ACTIVATOR:** There is a pot of gold under that rainbow and I have to go now to grab it before the rainbow disappears.
